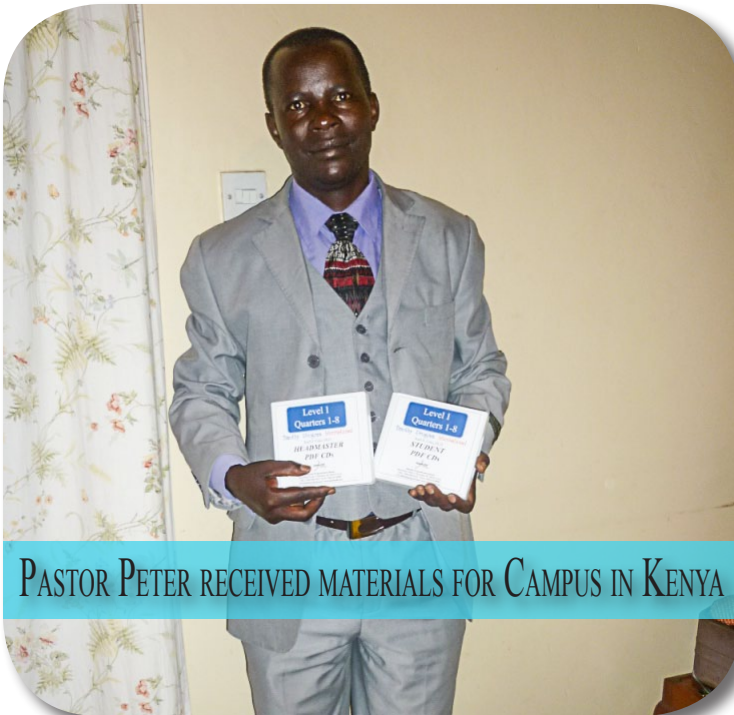

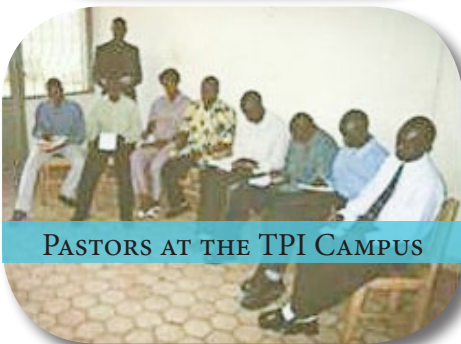

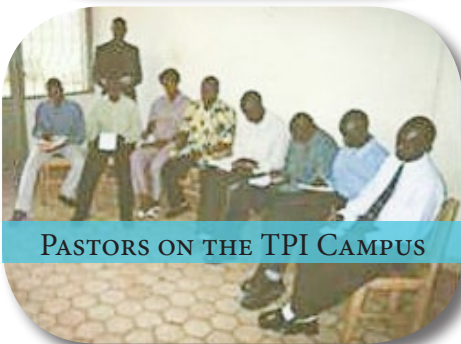

Bishop Agati writes: *"We hardly have the Bibles to give out. There is a great need for Bibles for the TPI students and the people. Bibles are very expensive [\$9.00] ... many people cannot afford to purchase a Bible for themselves."*
